ADNOC Sas Al Nakhl Summary of August Return to School

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with information about school reopening for the 2020/2021 academic year at ADNOC Schools – Sas Al Nakhl

We will follow our approved academic calendar for the AY 2020/21. The calendar is attached to this email for your reference. The first day of classes for students is Sunday August 30th, 2020. Following guidance from ADEK and the relevant government authorities, ADNOC Schools -SAN will be following a blended learning alternating week on/week off model. This means students will participate in face to face teaching on campus one week and the following week they will participate in distance learning at home. Please note these arrangements are subject to change pending updates from the relevant authorities.

School Reopening Model – Blended Model

• The school will resume operations whereby students return to school at a lower capacity using a blended learning approach (face-to-face and distance learning). The school will implement a partial return model where all eligible students are grouped into two alternating-week shifts. (Students attend school one week and do distance learning the following week, etc.)

Curriculum & Instruction

- We will be providing a full curriculum. This means non-core subjects will no longer be optional.
- Additional topics such as digital literacy and student well-being will be included in the curriculum
- At the start of the school year we will put in place all necessary interventions to fill any learning loss over the past few months, to revise and reteach topics as appropriate.

Campus specific information

- Our central Operational Risk & Safety team have been working with ADEK, health authorities and the team here at the school to establish the very best standards in regards to safety and health controls to help prepare our school for re-opening.
- Starting the week of August 23rd, 2020, you will begin to receive specific details regarding each of the three campuses from the Campus Heads. These details will include information such as entry and exit locations and timings, the Group that your children are assigned to, lunchtime procedures, arrangements and expectations for the weeks that your child will be involved in distance learning.
